All footwear is stitched with chemical resistant thread (tested to Industry Standards) which can resist heat, chemicals and welding sparks better than standard footwear thread.

Oliver SOFTtrac Dual Density Technology...

SOFTtrac Dual Density Nitrile Rubber Soling System utilises two layers of expanded rubber cells to provide a level of comfort and flexibility previously unknown in rubber soling.

SOFTtrac Technology Features:

- Heat Resistant Sole. Resistant to temperatures of 300° Celcius (572° Fahrenheit).
- Chemical Resistant Sole. Tested against caustic soda, most acids, mineral oils, alkalis.
- Superior Resistance to cutting and abrasion for the harshest of working conditions, but also light and flexible to provide exceptional wearer comfort.



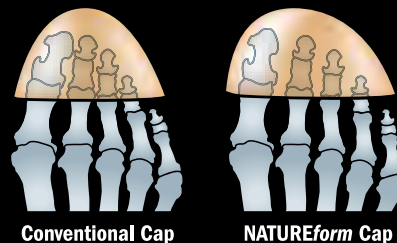
